west Indies on that firme.

¶ if you haue hives of beastes fit for sole Lether, &c. It
willbe a marchandize right good, and the sauages there yet
can not came Lether after our kinde, yet excellently after
their owne maner.

¶ if the soyle shall peelde Figgges, Almonds, Sugar
Canes, Quinces, Dynges, Lemons, Potatos, &c. there
may arise some trade and traffiche, by figges, almonds, su-
gar, marmelade, Sucket &c.

¶ if great woods bee founde, if they be of Cypres, chells
may bee made, if they bee of some kinde of trees, pitch and
tarre may be made, if they bee of some other then they may
peelde Rosin, Turpentine, &c. and al for trade and traffiche,
and Caskes for wine and oyle may be made: likewise shipp
and houses, &c.

And because traffiche is a thing so materiall, I wish that
great obseruation be taken whac euery soyle yeeldeth natu-
rally, in what commoditie soever, and what it may be made
to yeeld by industour, and to send vs notice home, that there-
upon wee may devise what meanes may be thought of to
rayse trades.

Nowe admite that we might not be suffered by the sauages
to enjoy any whole countrey or any more then the scope of a
Cittie, yet if wee might enjoy traffiche and be assured of the
same, wee might bee much enriched, our Maunie might be
increased, & a place of safetie might there be found, if change
of religion or ciuill warres shoulde happen in this realme,
which are thinges of great benefite. But if we may enioy
any large Territorie of apt soyle, we might so bse the mat-
ter, as we shoulde not depende upon Spaine for oyles, sacks,
resinges, oxenges, Lemons, Spanish skynnes, &c. Nor vpon
Fraunce for woad, baysalt, and gascoyne wynes, nor on Es-
lande for flaxe, pitch, tarre, matkes, &c. So we shoulde not so
exhaust our treasure, and so exceedingly iriche our doubt-
full friendes, as we doe, but shoulde purchasse the commodi-
ties that we want for halfe the treasure that now we do: but
