Between Queenston and Chippewa, two of the most historic towns in Canada, this line is situated on the brink of the Niagara River, and passengers do not for a moment lose sight of the seething waters of four inland oceans, as they rush downward to Lake Ontario.

From the Company's specially designed Observation Cars can be had the best possible views of the battle fields of Queenston Heights and Chippewa (through both of which the railway passes), Brock's Monument, the awful Gorge, the Whirlpool, the Whirlpool Rapids, the American and Horseshoe Falls, and the Rapids above the Falls. The whole of the Queen Victoria Jubilee Park is crossed at the very edge of the water, and the beautiful Dufrin Islands are reached by means of three immense steel bridges, which span portions of the roaring river.
