

## ARTICLE III.—MEMBERSHIP.

Any Canadian who served in the South African war of 1899-1902 shall be eligible to become a member of this Association upon payment of the requisite fees and dues and the production of satisfactory proof of his honourable discharge from the service, and further, upon signing this Constitution.

## ARTICLE IV.—OFFICERS.

The officers of the Association shall consist of one President, two Vice-Presidents, one Treasurer, one Secretary, and fifteen Committeemen, all of whom shall be elected annually and shall together form the Managing Committee.

## ARTICLE V.—FEES AND DUES.

The entrance fee shall be 50c., and the monthly dues shall be 25c., payable in advance.

## ARTICLE VI.—MEETINGS.

1. The annual meeting of the Association shall be held on the second Tuesday in the month of January in each year, at 8 o'clock in the evening. The election of officers shall take place at this meeting.

2. A special meeting of the Association may be called whenever the Managing Committee shall deem it expedient, or whenever the President shall be desired to call one by the written request of twenty members, setting forth the purposes thereof.
