



The Phases as seen at Charlottetown, July 29—

First contact of Moon with Sun's Limb, 58' from South point toward the West, 10h. 27m. a. m. Last contact 7' toward the East, 0h. 12m. p. m. Middle of Eclipse one-seventh of Sun's diameter obscured, 11h. 20m. a. m.

LUNAR OCCULTATIONS

There will be two occultations of Mars by the Moon, but neither favorable for observation here. They will

(I.) April 9th, Charlottetown, mean time of Conjunction in Right Ascension, 5h. 15m. 46sec. a. m. Moon below the horizon.

(II.) May 7, Charlottetown, mean time 5h. 30.37 p. m., broad daylight.
