BEGUN and holden at Saint John's on Thursday the Fourteenth Day of December, in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Eight, and in the Twelfth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Victoria by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith.

His Excellency Sir GASPARD LEMARCHANT, Governor, having by his Proclamation, bearing date the 22nd Day of November last, summoned and called together the Assembly of this Island, and appointed the same to meet at Saint John's on the 14th Day of December aforesaid.
