Fenian Celebrities.

The Toronto Telegraph openly accuses the Hibernian Society, of Toronto, of being a Fenjan circle. This is no more than whata great many suspected from its recent conduct with regard to Mike Murphy. A Fenjan paper published in New York has acknowledged it fraternally, and perhaps said more in its favour than was conductive to its health or existence. The Telegraph gives the recent history of the three of the members, and what they are doing for their country as follows:—A few years ago a fellow named Lomesnay worked in the Globe office here. He was a violent Fenjan in his language, and possessed of sufficient foolhardiness to be as violent in his actions. He belonged to the Hibernian Society, and we believe, held some minor office therein. He left the city shortly before the troubles began in Ireland, went to New York, and thence to Ireland in company with many others. In the army of the Republic he held the rank of captain, with a promise of immediate promotion should the undertaking prove successful. Unfortunately for him and others it was the reverse. He was captured near Cork, tried and found guilty, and sentenced to prison for a very long term. We have on it pretty good authority that the notorious Captain McKay is no other than Lomesnay, the former Globe compositor and Toronto Hibernian. No doubt he often wishes he were safe on this side the "herring pond" once more.

Another Toronto worthy, who has come to grief through his love for the Irish Republic, is Murty Moriarty. Murty was well known here, and was generally considered a harmless, innocent sort of a fellow. If all the Fenjans in Ireland are like him it is no wonder they have made such complete failures. He was remarkable for only one thing, and that was his nose, or rather the want of that useful and ornamental organ. It was injured in some scrimmage of his early days, and gradually disappeared, until Murty was left with nothing to blow. He went to Ireland about the same fate.
