are owing me are sending money in advance to mail order houses. I contribute money to any cause people say I am bidding for trade. If I don't they say I am a hog. Every day I am expected to dip up for everything that comes along, from a raffle ticket to a church fund by people who claim I ought to do that because they do part of their trading here, but our friends of the Temperance department stores neither tickets not help the church fund, yet they get the cash-in-advance business. If I sell a pair of pants must treat the family to candy cigars; if I buy a load of potatoes must do the same. Customers are able to pay, hang on their money, while I pay ten per cent advance to get ready cash. I have business during hard times and I crop from people who are willing to trade with me provided I can dictate catalogue house prices and until harvest for money. My son weighs too much when I sell sugar and too little when I buy butter. I am a thief, a liar and a graffer. I smile I am a soft soapy hypocrite and if I don't I am a grump. certainly, this is a snap." Ottawa, May 8—On May 21st there will be read in all the Anglican churches in Canada a pastoral letter signed by Archbishop Matheson, of Winnipeg, primate of all Canada, and Archbishop Hamilton, of Ottawa, metropolitan of the ecclesiastical province of Canada on the question of mixed marriages. The pastoral deprecate the performance of such marriages, but says that when performed they are indissoluble in the Church of Rome. The pastoral is issued as a result of the recent cases in Quebec, which it cites.

Toronto, Ont., May 27.—The Mail and Empire this morning says: "Another indication of the imminence of a federal general election was furnished by a report current in the city that J. G. Foley, the clerk of the crown-in-chancery, had come to Toronto and placed a rush order for several thousand ballot boxes with a local firm. Mr. Foley explained this by saying that at each general election trouble had been experienced in obtaining the use of sufficient ballot boxes. In the past some boxes used belonged to the federal government, some to the city of Toronto and some to the county of York. Mr. Foley stated that he had been endeavoring to make arrangements whereby the difficulties arising out of this diverse ownership of the ballot boxes will be obviated. It was said that the contract for the manufacture of the new ballot boxes has been let to the firm of Wheeler and Blair.
