in each session. And a Full Course shall consist of one hundred lectures on the following subjects :

- (a) Anatomy-
- (b) General Chemistry (including Organic Chemistry and Chemical Physics.)
- (c) Physiology.
- (d) Materia Medica.
- (e) Medicine.

(f) Surgery.

(9) Midwifery.

In Practical Chemistry, including Medical Chemistry, and Toxicology, so far as regards poisons gone over in the Course given, three demonstrations per week, given to any one class as below referred to (25 demonstrations being given to each class) shall constitute the Full/Course.

In Medical Jurisprudence and Toxicology the lectures shall consist of 38 on the former and 12 on the latter subject.

In Sanitary Science, 30 lectures shall constitute the Course.

In Clinical Medicine and Surgery, including every kind of Clinical Instruction, the Course will be determined from year to year, under arrangements sanctioned by the Corporation, made between the Clinical teachers of Trinity Medical College and those of other medical schools or colleges. And all such instruction shall be given at the Hospital.
