We look on the market as being in a very unhealthy condition, and rather excited by speculation in the face of con-iderable losses. It is to be regretted that so much of the Wall Street prideiple should be getting into our chief mait.

BUTTER.—Arrivals during the week have been fair, upply and demand about equal. Choice Dairy is lots readily taken at 17c. per lin good Store Packed like per lb. The foregoing are the prices realised by ourselves for lots during the week. We heard of selected line private advices by last mail, both from English and scotland, are more encovraging than those hibberto received. Sales of Canada Butter were made from St. 169; Stillings per cwt. We notice a large quantity of what is coming forward, not put up with the same care as we have seen in former seasons. We find a mostly all cases that fully 25 per cent. more salt is used in packing than is necessary for the proper curing of the Butter. Dealers cannot be too particular in preparing for market, as there is no other commedity of which the price is more governed by the quality than that of Butter.
