About 75% of above companies are located in 3 geographical areas: Metropolitan Region (Santiago), the V Region (Valparaiso) and the VIII Region (Concepción). These regions generate 77% of the industrial value added, and employ 78% of the industrial labor force.

The industrial output is typical for a less developed country: a high percentage of the industrial value added is placed in consumer products, specially in the food industry.
