acting within the scope of his duties or employment, shall be assimilated to, and be dealt with by Canada as if it were a claim arising out of the activities of a member of the Canadian Forces in the performance of his official duty in Canada, and any costs incurred in dealing with such claim shall be borne by Canada without any right to claim reimbursement from Denmark.

(b) Except as to claims mentioned in (a) of this paragraph, Article VIII of the Agreement Between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty Regarding the Status of Their Forces applies.

## Subsidiary Arrangements

18. Authorities of the Armed Forces of Denmark and Canada may enter into subsidiary arrangements as may be necessary to implement this agreement.
