THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR ARTHUR FADDEN, K.C.M.G, DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND TREASURER OF AUSTRALIA, AND THE HONOURABLE DONALD M. FLEMING, MINISTER OF FINANCE OF CANADA, ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA AND CANADA FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBLE TAXATION AND THE PREVENTION OF FISCAL EVASION WITH RESPECT TO INCOME TAXES WAS CONCLUDED AT MONT TREMBLANT TODAY.

THE AGREEMENT WAS SIGNED BY THE TWO MINISTERS IN THE CONFERENCE
HALL OF THE MONT TREMBLANT LODGE WHERE THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCE
MINISTERS' CONFERENCE IS TAKING PLACE. HIS EXCELLENCY, W.R.
CROCKER, AUSTRALIAN HIGH COMMISSIONER AND THE HONOURABLE GORDON
CHURCHILL, MINISTER OF TRADE AND COMMERCE OF CANADA ALSO PARTICIPATED
IN THE SIGNING CEREMONY.

THE AGREEMENT PROVIDES GENERALLY THAT EACH COUNTRY RETAINS
THE RIGHT TO TAX INCOME LEAVING THAT COUNTRY, WHILE AT THE SAME
TIME UNDERTAKING TO GRANT RELIEF FROM TAXATION ON INCOME IN
RESPECT OF WHICH A TAX HAS ALREADY BEEN IMPOSED IN THE OTHER COUNTRY.

THIS AGREEMENT WILL COME INTO FORCE ON THE DATE ON WHICH THE INSTRUMENTS OF RATIFICATION ARE EXCHANGED.
