

WINES, LIQUORS, &C.

XXVI.—No wines or other liquors are to be sent out of the house, on any pretence whatever. Nor will the practice of treating be permitted except to guests.

NOT TO TAKE AWAY PAPERS, &C.

XXVII.—No member shall take, or permit to be taken from the Club, on any pretence whatever, or shall injure or destroy any newspaper, pamphlet, or other article, the property of the Club.

COMPLAINTS.

XXVIII.—All complaints respecting the servants or domestic arrangements of the Club must be stated by letter, signed by the member complaining, which letter, addressed to the Secretary, must be laid by him before the committee, at their next weekly meeting.
