CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE XXXV.

A suspended member may be re-instated by a two third vote of the members present at a regular meeting. Any member having been expelled shall not be proposed for membership under six months from the date of expulsion.

ARTICLE XXXVI., VIOLATING PLEDGE.

The charge of violating Article II. shall be presented in writing, duly signed, when it shall be referred to a committee of three members, who shall, as soon as practicable, summon the parties, and investigate the matter.

ARTICLE XXXVII.

If the committee agree that the charge is sustained they shall report the fact, with a resolution to the effect that the brother be expelled—which report and resolution may be considered at the same meeting when presented if the offending brother has been notified by the committee to be present.

ARTICLE XXXVIII.

If a majority of the members present at a regular meeting vote in favor of the resolution of the committee, the offending person shall forfeit his membership, and be declared expelled from the order.

ARTICLE XXXIX.

All votes to expel a member under this, and the previous article, shall be done with ball ballots.

ARTICLE XL., CARDS.

A card of withdrawal may be granted to a brother. who desires to join another Lodge. A travelling card may be granted to a brother, on his paying his regular dues for the period for which he desires it.

ARTICLE XLL, QUORUM.
