reporting that a Protestant had become, not a vert to truth, but a proselyte to your system. I sir, you must excuse me; I cannot, will not, suffe further trespass upon my time. Good evening!"

Thus, the influence of Gideon presided in the dy chamber of Ralph, within telling him to—Behold Saviour of mankind, and without guarding him fr the irruption of the Jesuits. We must firmly he that the spirits of the two brothers met at the feet Him before whom they who repent early, and the who repent late, equally know that they have nough wherein to glory, although they will also know the only the former had the best of both worlds.

Mr. Bonsall brought away the remains of his und thankful that the teeth of the Inquisition were draw He laid him in the same grave with Gideon, as erected one monument over the two brothers. Over Ralph he wrote—

"The strong man of war and turmoil,
Lay down like a meek and humble child,
Forgetful of
The glories and vanities of the world,
Seeking salvation eternal
