Boundary Coal Beds.

Last fall I interviewed Mr. Edward Davis, a Welsh coal mining expert, who for the past 20 years has worked in coal mines in Pennsylvania, U.S. He was sent up to Rock Creek to report on coal beds located there, and assured me that from his experience he would promise an unlimited quantity of coal of good quality and most suitable for coking. When the company take hold of this, which they intend to do shortly, it will mean everything to the smelter industry. A big Chicago company are likely to take it up and instal an up-to-date plant, negotiations for which are under way at present.

In connection with the coal deposits on this same property, a seven-foot stratum of the best quality fire clay is opened up.
