Makes a General Advance; Philadelphia, Pa., Sept. 29.—The Philadelphia and Reading Coat and Iron Company to-day announced a general advance in the list prices of authracte coal, to take effect Oct. 1. The tidewater rates have uniformly advanced 25c per ton, and the rates for line and city trade have been increased 10c per ton on broken coal and 25c on egg, stove and chestnut.
