

WHEAT MARKET SEEMS SICK

Liverpool Cables Lower and a Decline in Chicago.

Continental Markets Were Generally Quiet - Corn Opened Firm in Chicago and Advanced - Provisions Closed Steady - Latest Commercial News.

Wednesday Evening, Nov. 29. Lower wheat cables from Liverpool came as a surprise to the Chicago market.

Wheat in store at Fort William and Port Arthur on Nov. 29 was 1,710,788 bushels, an increase of 1,338,018 bushels over Nov. 21, and 15,650 bushels a year ago.

Montreal sent out 1,844,000 boxes of cheese to Europe the past season, which compares favorably with 1,800,000 boxes in 1928.
