The receipts, chiefly from collections, during the year have been \$141.32; expenditure, \$120.37; leaving a balance of \$20.95.

During the year the S. Schools have had published for their own use a new "Sabbath School Hymnal." This is very much more suitable and serviceable for them than any of the various Sunday School Hymn Fooks which it has hitherto been possible to procure. An outlay to the amount of \$78.80, not included in the preceding statement, has been thereby incurred.

The Weekly Prayer Meeting which is held in the Lecture Room of the Church every Wednesday Evening, at half-past seven o'clock, has been more largely attended during the past winter than formerly: there is still, how-

ever, room for improvement in this respect.

All young men connected with the congregation are cordially invited to attend. At present there are only 30 regular members; but it is hoped that a larger number will avail themselves of the opportunities for mutual improvement which the Association offers.
