I. An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, Feb. 23. Visible in South America. Africa, and Southern Europe.

II. A total Eclipse of the Sun, August 18. Visible in Eastern Africa, Southern Asia, and in Australia.

A Transit of Mercury over the Sun's disc will occur November 5. invisible in P. E. Island.

Venus, after July 16. Mars, from Jan. 2, to Nov. 13. Jupiter, from March 10 to July 4. Saturn: until Feb. 24, and after Nov. 29.

Evening Stars.

Venus until July 16. Mars until Jan. 2, and after Nov. 13. Jupiter until March 10, and after July 4.

Saturn, from Feb. 24 to Nov. 29.

The Four Seasons.

Winter begins, 1867, December 22, 1h 31m mo., and lasts 89d 0h 56m. Spring begins, 1868, March 20, 2h 27m mo., and lasts 92d 20h 27m. Summer begins, 1868, June 20, 10h 54m eve., and lasts 93d 11h 31m. Autumn begins, 1868, Sept. 22, 1h 25m eve., and lasts 89d 17h 55m. Winter begins, 1868, Dec. 21, 7h 20m morn. Trop. year, 365d 5h 49m.
