They are generally very high up, sometimes covering the face Boilers, of the sky with thin transparent gauze. If their under surface be horizontal, and their fibres point upwards, they indicate rain ; it CIRRUS. downwards, fine weather, wind or drought. If cirrus clouds form during fine weather, with a falling barometer, it is almost sure to rain. Specialties
