Interview With Capt. R. A. Lockett in San Francisco Paper—Busy in War Work
His friends in this city will read with interest an interview with Captain R. A. Lockett which appears in a San Francisco newspaper. Captain Lockett is a native of St. John and sailed from this port for years, before settling in California, where he now makes his home. His wife, who was Miss Alice Clarke, is a sister of George H. Clarke and Mrs. Robert Fawcett of West St. John. The article referred to is as follows:
Captain R. A. Lockett laughs at submarines, hal—like that.
For three years he has been plying the sub-infested waters of the Mediterranean and Indian oceans on the liner Nile, now a troopship for the British government. Last night when he arrived in San Francisco from Vancouver (B. C.), he said:

not been in San Francisco for more than three years, and therefore saw Market street for the last time before the jitter bug made dodging a fine art, one can realize how safe he really considers the job.
"The only submarine I saw during the whole time," he said, "was tied up at a dock. Why, during the whole war I've only heard of three transports that they got."
Captain Lockett admitted that he had been handling thousands of troops during the last three years, taking them all sorts of places except to France. He said he had taken them to Africa and India and did not deny that a lot of the men who are now treading the sands of Palestine and Mesopotamia went over on his ship. Still he refused to say that adventure in the form of plungers or mines had ever come his way.
"This country won't experience any trouble in getting her troops across to France, either. There's plenty of vessels going out, and all they have to do is put men on them."
One could see that the whole matter, with Captain Lockett, was as simple as waving the right or the left hand.
"There are still plenty of ships," he continued. "They are building them right along. And over here there is more activity than I have seen anywhere else."
The captain went on to say that so far as any general knowledge of the situation was concerned one skipper of a transport knew nothing except where he was to take his own ship, and that was all.
"We Go, That's All."
"They tell us to go and we go," he said. "That's all there is to it. We never hear anything about the other vessels unless we read it in the papers."
"It's the same way about the air raids in London. You never know anything about them except what you read, unless you go down and have a look for yourself."
