CARS FOR FOREIGN MARKET TO BE BUILT IN CANADA

Walkerville, Aug 5—Canada's automobile industry will develop a decided impetus through the decision of the Studebaker Corporation, just announced, to build all its cars for the foreign market in the Canadian factory in Walkerville.

This decision means the employment of several hundred skilled workmen and the operation of the Canadian plant to full capacity during the entire year.

Hitherto Studebaker cars for the foreign trade have been built in Detroit, but an investigation proved that this branch of the business could be carried on more economically and efficiently from Canada, and as a result, the output of the Studebaker factory in this town will be multiplied several times.

Already work has started on fitting up the Canadian plant to meet the increased demand, and in a short time upwards of 800 men will be employed. New and modern machinery is being placed in position, traveling cranes and air compressors installed, rubber decks and finishing rooms built and railway sidings rearranged and increased.

The foreign market consumes from twelve to fifteen per cent. of the Studebaker output, and highly successful agencies are maintained in practically every country in Europe, in South America, South Africa, Australia, China, and Japan. While the war has interfered with exports in certain countries, Studebaker sales in all parts of the British Empire, South America and the Far East show a healthy increase.
