MUSIC AS PEACEMAKER.

Montreal, Feb. 1.—The development of music as a means of fostering the community spirit and bringing closer together the English and French races in Montreal was strongly advocated by Dr. Boris Dunev, of the Canadian Academy of Music, in an address to the St. James' Literary Society. After the music which differed in all else, music provided a common meeting ground, and by understanding each other musically they could reach a greater degree of sympathy. Dr. Dunev emphasized the need for a municipal conservatory of music which would be the foundation of the city's future musical life.

It pictures the scene in Warsaw in 1768, when the Poles, under the force of Russian pressure, renounced their right to have their own parliament.
