SWINGING THE AXE IN SELF-DEFENCE

Man Charged With Murder Pleads His Life Was Threatened.

Hamilton, Jan. 31.—All the evidence was taken before adjournment at 6 o'clock this evening in the supreme court in the case of Harton Semonovich, charged with having murdered John Rapschinski. Mr. Justice Kelly then adjourned the court until tomorrow morning when the case will be given to the jury, following addresses by the counsel for the crown and for the defence. This afternoon the prisoner entered the witness box in his own behalf, and while he admitted having the axe in his hand, and swinging it when Rapschinski was struck by it, he said he saw trouble brewing and that his life had been threatened by John Vitazio and John Rapschinski, and that he was swinging the axe in self-defence. Rapschinski, he said, kept running underneath the axe while he was swinging it, and consequently received a blow from the weapon. He did not intend, however, to hit him.

WILL PROTEST NOBEL AWARD TO POISON GAS CHEMIST

Paris, Jan. 31.—The action of the committee on the Nobel prizes in giving the award for distinction in chemical research to Hier Haber, a German associated with Professor Fisher in inventing and perfecting poison gas, is to be the subject of a protest by chemists in Entente countries. The Haber award was given ostensibly for his research in connection with obtaining nitrogen from the atmosphere, but his selection in view of his poison-gas reputation excites very unfavorable comment against the Scandinavian committee entrusted with the distribution of these prizes.
