The great rise and fall of the tide in our harbor and the velocity of the currents combine to produce peculiar conditions which must be taken into consideration when the subject of improving our harbor is discussed. Every wharf which projects into the current produces an eddy, and every eddy becomes a means of depositing mud and rubbish borne by the tide against this silineality continual dredging is necessary, and this is something that cannot be had unless special provision is made for it. An ordinary dredge is of very little used in a harbor where the rise and fall of the tide is so great as it is in St. Albaks. 
