Sir

I have the honor to acknowledge your favor of the 23<sup>rd</sup> inst., in regard to the application made by Chief Askan for the subdivision by survey of the St. Peters Indian Reserve, etc.

I have consulted with Chief Askan, & what he requires is to have the bar line of the inner two miles as per survey of 1874. run again, & posts placed so that every one who lives along the Red River will know where his ~~the~~ boundaries begin from. — He does not ask to have these lines run out the two miles.

outside the ~~\*~~ outer two miles, or what is known as the St. Peters Parish, to be divided into sections as per Dominion Survey's, with the exception of the hay fields at the north end of the Reserve which are to be in common
