Cooper, requesting this Council to petition the Dominion Parliament to increase the duty on certain printed paper to the same rate as that on unprinted paper. In reply to that letter your committee recommended that the following communication be sent:

Dear Sir, I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th ultimo, asking this Council to pass a resolution to be sent to the Minister of Finance, to request that a duty be placed on printed paper equal to the duty already imposed on unprinted paper. You also state that this would not be an act of protection. We have no intention to quibble as to words, but permit us to call your attention to the fact that all taxes imposed in that manner are protective taxes of the worst kind.
