WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section (180 acres, more or less) of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency os Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by prozy may be made at any agency, on sertain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

DUTLES.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and accupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his hemestead. Price 2500 per acre. Dutles.—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extre.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$2.00 per acre. Purchased homesteads may be acquired on any available lands on either odd or even humbered Sections south of Township 55, east of the Calgary and Edmonton Rallway and the west line of Range 26, and west of the third Meridian and the Bault Rallway line. Dutles.—Must reside six menths in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.
