**QUESTION.—What Ministers or Probationers for the Ministry have died during the year?****WILLIAM YOKOM.**

Rev. Wm. Yokom departed this life in great peace on the 30th day of April, 1889, in the town of Aylmer. Brother Yokom was born in St. Catharines, Ont., September 17th, 1819, and was converted to God September 3rd, 1838, under the labors of the Rev. Leonard Salisbury. He became an exhorter in the Methodist Church while a young convert, afterward a local preacher, travelling some five years under the Presiding Elder. He became a member of the Niagara Conference of the late Methodist Episcopal Church in 1858. His first appointment was to the Walsingham Circuit, thence to Chatham, and after twenty years of faithful service in the itinerancy, he closed his effective ministry on the Tilson-
