An Act to amend the Act to regulate the duties between Master and Servant, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act passed in the session Preamble, held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to regulate the duties between Master and Servant, and 10 & 11 V., other purposes therein mentioned;" Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts c. 28. 5 as follows:

I. For and notwithstanding any thing in the recited Act contained, Justice to any one or more Justices of the Peace shall have full power and the private the authority to act under the eighth section of the said Act, whether any the term of labourer or servant shall at the time of such complaint or subsequent service has 10 thereto, be and continue in, or shall have been dismissed from, or shall expired. be out of the actual service or employment of any such master or employer: Provided, that in the event of any dismissal or being out of Proviso. actual service, any complaint under the twelfth section of the said Act, shall be made within the period of six months from the termination 15 of the service.

II. This Act shall apply only to Upper Canada.
