The Honorable Mr. *Huzen* from the said Committee reported that they had taken the said Bill into consideration, had made some further progress therein, and had directed him to ask leave to sit again.

Ordered, That the said Committee have leave to sit again to-morrow.

Then on motion of the Honorable Mr. Hamilton (Kingston), seconded by the Honorable Mr. McClelan,

The House adjourned.
