

two pence, in full Satisfaction for defraying the Charges of Forage, Bread Waggon, Train of Artillery, and Train of Provisions, Wood, Straw, &cetra, and all other extraordinary Expences, Contingencies, and Losses whatsoever, incurred and to be incurred, on account of His Majesty's Army, consisting of Thirty-eight thousand Men, actually employed against the Common Enemy, in concert with the King of Prussia, from the Twenty-eighth Day of November last, to the Twenty-fourth Day of December next, inclusive; the said Sum to be issued, from time to time, in like Proportions as the Pay of the said Troops; and any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Six hundred and seventy thousand pounds, to enable His Majesty to make good His Engagements with the King of Prussia, pursuant to a Convention between His Majesty and the King of Prussia, concluded April the Eleventh, One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight.

And it is hereby also enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That out of all or any the Aids or Supplies provided as aforesaid, there shall and may be issued and applied any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Eight hundred thousand pounds, to enable His Majesty to discharge the like Sum raised in pursuance of an Act made in the last Session Parliament, and charged upon the First Aids or Supplies to be granted in this Session of Parliament.

And it is hereby also enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That out of all or any the Aids or Supplies provided as aforesaid, there shall and may be issued and applied, any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Eight hundred thousand pounds, upon Account to enable His Majesty to defray any extraordinary Expences of the War, incurred, or to be incurred, for the Service of the Year One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight, and to take all such Measures, as may be necessary to disappoint or defeat any Enterprizes or Designs of His Enemies, and as the Emergency of Affairs may require.

And it is hereby also enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That out of all or any the Aids or Supplies provided as aforesaid, there shall and may be issued and applied, any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Nine thousand nine hundred two pounds, and five shillings, upon Account, for supporting and maintaining the Settlement of His Majesty's Colony of Nova Scotia, for the Year One thousand seven hundred and fifty eight; and any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Six thousand six hundred twenty six pounds, nine shillings, and nine pence halfpenny, upon Account, for defraying the Charges incurred by supporting and maintaining the Settlement of His Colony in 1756, not pro-
