Penitentiary Regulations.

GENERAL.

Officers shall not receive any additional salary or which he is employed.

Sec. 398. No officer shall, for any service or work in any manner or under any circumstances, done either under the direction of the Department of Justice, or the Department of emolument for services at Public Works, for or in respect of the penitentiary at which he is employed, be paid any salary or emolument in addition to that hereby prescribed, and for such salary the warden may exact any service for which by reason of his office or qualifications such officer is fitted.
