He's great. Wanted Flora but since she didn't win, I'm glad he did.



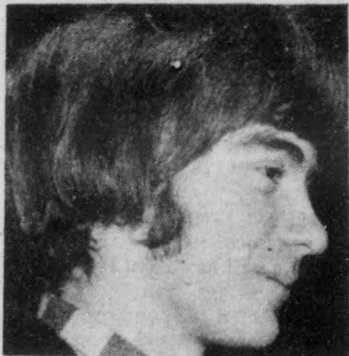

Think he's another Stanfield about 15 years younger. He's a Red Tory and I'm sorry Wagner didn't win.



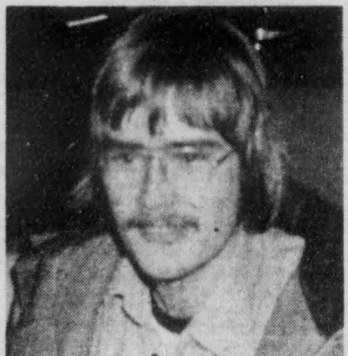

I think Illa would have been a far better choice.



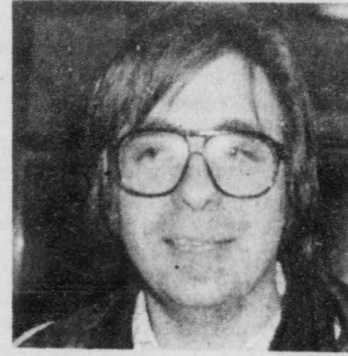

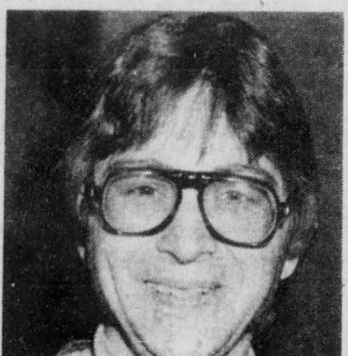
