

\$2.4 million expansion

The Mississauga water purification plant is about to undergo a \$2.4 million expansion.

The work proposed involves a major addition to filters which would in-crease the capacity of the present plant from 24 million gallons per day to 48

Engineering consultants Gore and Storrie Limited report that this expansion of the Lakeview plant will be necessary to meet the growing needs of Mississauga. The report in dicates plans would be complete by the end of 1968 and construction by the sum-

mer of 1970. Water Commission chairman Joe Dobbs advised that the commission carry on with plans

for expansion despite the OWRC's plans to take over the water plant.

"It seems reasonable to proceed in these matters even though it is planned that the OWRC will be taking over," said Mr. Dobbs. "We are anxious to avoid any delays in our program which would cause a water shortage in Mississauga. We are generally stretched to the limit when additions are completed, and the rapid growth of Mississauga makes very careful scheduling necessary.'

The commission is now completing a new low lift pumping station and chemical feed building at a cost of \$1 million, which will have the capacity to supply water to the new
