

This Indenture made and concluded at Can-
da in Canada East this twenty fourth day of Septem-
ber in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and forty five by and between James
Farlinger of the first part and Allen Lincoln of the
second part witnesseth that the said James
Farlinger for and in consideration of one hundred
and seventy dollars to him in hand paid by the
said Allen Lincoln the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged Hath granted bargained devised
and to farm let and by these presents doth com-
mit and to farm let unto the said Allen
Lincoln his heirs and assigns all and singular that
certain piece or parcel of land and tenements situate
and lying and being in said St. Regis Reservation
in the Township of Lennox in Canada East upon
said and being comprised of the north west
corner of lot number thirty one in the first
concession of said Indian Reservation in Canada
aforesaid containing seventeen arpents of land
more or less and is bounded as follows begin-
ning at the North west corner of said lot num-
ber thirty one, running along said South westerly
line ninety nine rods and seven links to the
north west corner of Horatio Spruells land thence
North easterly twenty four rods along the northern
by line of said Horatio Spruells land, thence
North westerly and parallel to and with the
South westerly line of said concession, thence
South westerly along the westerly line of said
concession line to the place of beginning con-
taining seventeen arpents of land, To Have
and to hold the same with the appurtenances
unto the said Allen Lincoln his heirs
and assigns for ever from the day and date of
the original grant from the Chiefs of the St. Regis
Indians to Antoine Rupa bearing date the
one and twenty of November 1844 within the full
and one term of ninety nine years and so
