

Grey South (Continued)August 1st,

Organizer Adams reports from Durham that he conferred with Secretary Charles Ramage and with J.H. Hunter member of the Executive. William Calder ex Provincial candidate was absent to-day. South Grey requires considerable stirring up, and our friends appear to be waiting for the return of H.H. Miller ex M.P. President Dr. Mearns is not thought to be giving adequate attention to the work of revision. Secretary Ramage is active worker and apparently doing his utmost. Ramage has sent letter to the active workers in each Township urging revision of the lists. It is intended to call a convention in October. Apparently H.H. Miller is favorably regarded as Dominion candidate and Calder for Provincial candidate.

I circularized the whole riding when I got supplies of blanks inviting correspondence and urging activity in revision. I had only one response from Sullivan Township asking for blanks, but I have heard no result.

You wrote me some days ago asking about Clubs. Reform Liberal Clubs. I do not think that one exists in the riding. I know of none.

Our next candidate for the Local House will be again, Wm. Calder. Though not yet nominated he has his eyes open but was too busy to look after the townships this year. The assessors in fully half of the Municipalities were friendly.
