
Ottawa, April 6, 1909.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ult. forwarding the bond of yourself and Messrs. J.A. Kalbfleisch and M.J. Dubois.

In reply I beg to say that it was not necessary for you to furnish this bond. On Feb. 23, last, the Indian Commissioner was informed that the Department has decided to arrange with certain guarantee companies to furnish at the expense of the Department security from all agents from whom it is required, and therefore that it was not necessary for you to do anything further in the matter.
