Sir,

I have the honour to call your attention to my letter of the 2nd instant, with reference to lot 19, con. A, Koppul, in which, I regret to say, an error occurred in regard to the arrears due on this lot.

In March 1879, a reduction in the price of the lot was granted, from \$3⁰⁰ to \$1⁰⁰ per acre, which reduction was not noted in the sales'book in the Department, at the time, by the clerk then in charge, and consequently the balance was shown to be \$218⁰⁰, whereas it should have been \$43⁰⁰, and interest thereon at 6 per cent, from 9th March, 1877 until paid.
