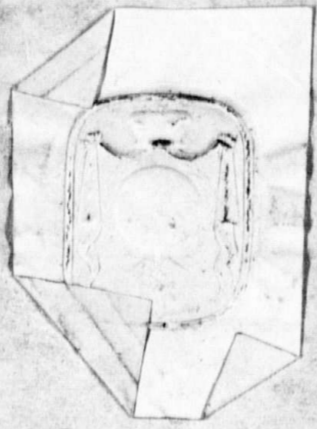

Greeting

Whereas it hath been certified to me by the Board of Examiners for the Dis-
trict of Quebec appointed under and by virtue of an Act passed in the Parliament of the said Province in the first
year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord William The Fourth by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great
Britain and Ireland King Defender of the Faith, intituled, "An Act to repeal a certain Act or Ordinance therein
mentioned and to provide effectual regulations concerning the practice of Physic, Surgery and midwifery" That Main
Joseph Pambrun of the City of Quebec, Esquire, hath been by them examined and hath been found, in all
respects duly qualified to be licensed to practice as a Physician, Surgeon and man midwife within the said Province
And whereas the said Main Joseph Pambrun hath prayed by reason of the Certificate of the said Board
of Examiners that a License to practice as a Physician, Surgeon and man midwife within the said Province
may be granted unto him. Now Know Ye that I do hereby under and by virtue of the powers in me vested
by the said Act of the Parliament of the said Province permit and license the said Main Joseph
Pambrun to practice as a Physician, Surgeon and man midwife within the said Province of Lower Canada.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal at arms at the
Castle of Saint Louis in the City of Quebec in the said Province of Lower Canada the
fourteenth day of October In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
thirty four and in the Fifth year of His Majesty's Reign
