And then what happened ? I then reported it to Colonel Richmond, the School Q.15 Commandant. You reported the incident and then what happened ? Colonel Richmond instructed me to get the R.S.M. of the School, go to Sergeant Campbell's quarters and Q.16 A. give him a direct order to take over the squad. To take over his squad ? 9.17 To take over his squad. As a result of these instructions from the Commandant Q.18 what did you do, Captain Williams I got the R.S.M. - R.S.M. Clarke of S.4 Canadian Small Arms School and proceeded to the Staff Sergeants Quarters in the Camp. What time would that be ? At approximately 0905 hours on the 11th of September, 9.19 1944, I met Sergeant Campbell outside. I said to Sergeant Campbell "I am giving you a direct order." Do you remember the exact words you used at the time. 9.20 It is important-as nearly as you can remember. "You will goto your squad room immediately and take over your squad" Sergeant Campbell said "You have me over a barrel" I said "The answer must be "Yes" or "No". Sergaant Campbell replied, after some hestation, "The answer is no, sir." As a result of the direct order which you have testified having given Sergeant Campbell, did he in fact proceed Q. 21 to the squad room and take over his squad ? No, sir. A. Has he at any time since taken over his squad ? 0.22 No. sir. As a result of the - what action was taken by you or anybody to your knowledge, as a result of the refusal 9.23 to obey the direct order ? Going back to the first statement by Campbell when he came into the Orderly Room. I might mention my A. reaction. There was a point there. The reason I didn't give the direct order at that time. That was the first thing on Monday morning at 0800 hours hours. Knowing at that time the Sergeant was quite worried about his wife; the reason I returned him to his quarters and did not order him to the squad room, I thought he might get over it during the day, that the way he was feeling was the reason why he wouldn't go in and take the squad over that morning. I appreciate the fact he came in and said he didn't feel he could do I appreciated the squad justice.
