

SEVENTH WITNESS: 6145981 Cpl Richards W H, 276 Coy Pioneer Corps attached 120 CMP Guard Room, having been duly sworn states:

"At Brussels Prince Albert Barracks Guard Room on the night of 27 Nov 1944 I was on duty when the accused Pte Giroux whom I recognize was brought in by Cdn Provost staff. I relieved him of the contents of his hat and placed them in a bag to be taken to the property room for safe keeping. These are some of the items which I took off Pte Giroux when he was admitted: Cigar Case(brown) (exhibit "A"), silver cigarette case (Exhibit "B") ladies compact (exhibit "C") silver pocket watch(exhibit "D") nail file (exhibit "E") one razor set(Exhibit "F") one handkerchief (Exhibit "G") and one pair of gloves(Exhibit "H"). I see these items here in front of me now and I recognize them.

Accused declines to cross-examine.

EIGHTH WITNESS: 547906 Cpl Smith S, 276 Coy Pioneer Corps having been duly sworn states:

"I do duty locking prisoners in and out also of looking after their personal effects. On the 4 Dec 44 I gave Lieut Connors the following items from the property of Pte Giroux whom I recognize and who was present when I did so: one pocket watch, one ladies compact, one nail file one cigar case(leather) one razor and blades, one pair of gloves, and one handkerchief. I also gave him this silver cigarette case about 3 or four days ago, all these items had adhesive tape (brown) placed on them on the 4 Dec 44 when I handed them over and put my name on each piece. The accused's hat is kept locked in the property room and I got these items from it today".

Accused declines to cross-examine.

"Sir I recognize the following articles now in front of me as being among the items of property which Pte Giroux had in his possession on the night of the 27-28 Nov 44 when I took them off him in the American Police station: Leather cigar case(exhibit "A"), silver cigarette case (exhibit "B"), red ladies compact(exhibit "C"), one pocket watch(exhibit "D"), green handled nail file (exhibit "E"), a safety razor (exhibit "F"), one handkerchief(exhibit "G") and one pair of leather gloves (Exhibit "H")

Accused declines to cross-examine.
