witness - I suddenly heard a commotion in the next room. I went in and there I saw Private Plante holding Corporal Girard by the collar of his tunic and I saw him strike the corporal with his fist.

Prosecutor - How far away from Corporal Girard were you standing?

witness - Seven or eight feet away.

Prosecutor - Was anyone else close to Corporal Girard?

witness - Yes there were other men standing around.

Prosecutor - Then what happened?

witness - When Corporal Girard fell down I saw him getting up and turning to see who had hit him. Private Plante then ran out of the room.

Prosecutor - Did Private Plante run away before Corporal Girard got up?

witness - He ran away as he turned as was getting up.
