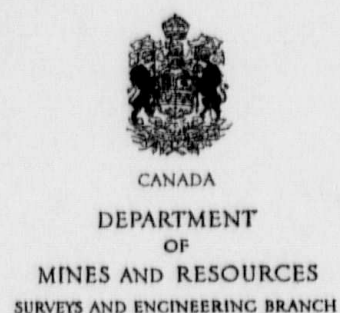

Dear Sir: Your file 30/14/3685

Reference your letter August 15th
enclosing a communication of August 14th from
Mr. Ball regarding proposed change in pipeline
for the domestic water system on Chekwelp Indian
Reserve No. 26.

We take it Mr. Ball suggests securing an
easement for the pipeline from the owner of Lot "E",
Mr. Rhodes, but does not mention securing any right
of way agreement with the owner of Lot "D", Ruth
Paine.

Any feasible route which is satisfactory
to Mr. Ball should be acceptable and if he will
indicate to us his proposals and secure the necessary
easements, we will endeavour to have them implemented.
