With further reference to your letter of the 12th instant in connection with the failure of the above mentioned young Indian of the Lytton Band to report for a medical examination when ordered to do so by the Divisional Registrar, I beg to advise you that I have now interviewed this man. He informs me that he received his orders last Fall when working for the C.N.R. at Kamloops. Raphael has since lost his papers in this respect. I have impressed upon him the seriousness of his failure to report and would ask that a new set of the necessary papers in this respect be forwarded through this Office. I will then see that Raphael receives same in good time and that he reports to the Doctor for a medical examination at an early date.
