PREFACE

He was in the Yukon first in 1893 and ran the first steamboat on the Upper Yukon River from Forty-Mile to Five Finger Rapids and Stewart River, a distance of three hundred miles; the name of the steamboat was The Pelly. The boat was of 10 H.P. owned by Harper & Leduc, of Selkirk and Sixty-Mile posts.
