

REPORT OF CLERK WHEN APPLYING FOR CERTIFICATE UNDER SEC. 18.

To the Judge of the County Court of the County of *Victoria*I, *George Andrew Balfour*
Clerk of the Municipality of *Omenaca*
of *Victoria*

in the said County

do hereby certify as follows:

That I did, on the *Twenty ninth* day of *July* 1891, post up, and for the period of thirty days next thereafter keep posted up in a conspicuous place in my office at *Omenaca* a true and correct printed copy of the Voters' List for the said Municipality of *Omenaca* for 1891, made in pursuance of "The Ontario Voters' List Act, 1889," with the certificate required by section seven of the said Act endorsed thereon.

That I did also duly deliver and transmit by *Mail* registered, the required number of similar printed copies of the said Voters' List, with my certificate endorsed, to each and all of the persons entitled to the same under sections five and six of said Act.

That I did on the *Thirtieth* day of *July* 1891 cause to be inserted in the newspaper called the "*Journal*" published in *Omenaca* the notice required by section nine of the said Act.

That no person gave me nor did I receive any written notice of complaint and intention to apply to the Judge or Junior or acting Judge of the County Court of said County of *Victoria* in respect to the said Voters' List within thirty days after I, the said Clerk, had posted up the said List in my office, as directed by the provisions of the said Act.

And That to the best of my knowledge and belief I have complied with the several requirements of the said Act, so as to entitle me to apply for certified copies under section sixteen of the said Act; and I do hereby, in pursuance thereof, now apply to you the said Judge to certify three of the copies of the said List received by you as being the Revised List of Voters for the Municipality of the said *Village* of *Omenaca* for the year of our Lord 1891.
