Trinity University, Toronto

Is not merely a Divinity School—it is the Church University of Ontario, with 7 Faculties and 5 Colleges.

Faculties: Arts, Divinity, Medicine, Law, Music, Dentistry, Divinity

Colleges: Trinity, St. Hilda's, Trinity Medical, Ontario Medical College for Women, Toronto Conservatory of Music

Trinity College School, Port Hope, is a preparatory school for all of these.

St. Hilda's College

On the Trinity Grounds, is the only University Residence for Women in this province. The women students attend lectures in Trinity College.

Special Courses for Non-Matriculated Students of both sexes are provided in all the languages, Ancient and Modern, History and Economics, Natural Science in all its branches, Mathematics and Actuarial Science, Church History and Biblical subjects, and in English.

The Reverend Professor Clark

has just been appointed Professor of English Literature and will offer especially attractive courses for both matriculated and non-matriculated students. In this department he will be ably assisted by Mr. H. C. Simpson, M.A., of Magdalene College, Oxford, who has already been very successful in this kind of work.

Scholarships, Prizes, Bursaries and Exhibitions

Valuable scholarships, carrying with them free tuition for the whole course, are offered at matriculation and subsequently. Desirable prizes are offered in the final year and in the Divinity class. Bursaries and Exhibitions are offered by the University, private benefactors, and the various dioceses for the benefit of clergymen's sons and others in the faculties of Arts and Divinity.

Trinity Matriculation Examinations

are held in July in every High School and Collegiate Institute in the province, as well as in Convocation Hall. Supplemental examinations are held in September in the Convocation Hall only.

The Divinity School

in its equipment, is second to none in the Canadian Church. It is to be further strengthened by the addition of two new professors in October. It is the only Divinity School in Ontario whose teaching is under the control of all the Ontario Bishops.

The Main Features of Trinity are:

- 1.—Combination of Biblical Instruction with Secular Learning.
- 2.—Individual attention inside and outside of the lecture-rooms.
- 3.—Daily intercourse in residence with the staff.
- 4.—Residences for both sexes, with all of their educative influences and the safeguards of a healthy undergraduate opinion, which cannot be felt in lodging houses in the city, where students are left entirely to themselves.
