Notes to Electric Railway Statistics.

(1) The B.S. Ry. is owned by the City of Berlin, Ont.; it has 0.78 mile of double track and 0.41 mile of sidings.

(2) The B. and H. Ry., the H. and D. Ry., the H.G. and B.E.R., the H.R.R., and the H.S.R. are owned by the Dominion Power and Transmission Co. The B. and H. Ry. freight car mileage was 29,538, and 4,978 tons of freight were carried. The H. and D. Ry. freight car mileage was 98, and 227 tons of freight were carried. The H. G. and B.E. Ry. freight car mileage was 48,878, and 64,160 tons of freight were carried. The H.R. Ry. has 8.69 miles of double track; its freight cars ran 21,819 miles and carried 11,951 tons of freight. (3) The B.C.E. Ry. has 59.40 miles of double track lines, and 27.59 miles of sidings; it leases 140.66 miles of track, including the Vancouver and Lulu Island Ry. from the C.P.R., and the Vancouver, Fraser Valley and Southern Ry. Its freight cars ran 905,027 miles and carried 256,083 tons of freight.

(4) The C.M.R. is owned by the City of Calgary, Alta.; it has 10 miles of double track, and one mile of sidings.

(5) The C.B.E.R. is owned by the Cape Breton Electric Co., which operates an electric lighting, and power, service and a ferry service. It has 1.05 miles of sidings.

(6) The C.W. and L.E. Ry. has six miles of sidings. Its freight cars ran 39,270 miles and carried 71,347 tons of freight. (7) The C.E. Ry. has 2.50 miles of sidings.

(8) The E.R.R. is owned by the City of Edmonton, Alta.

(9) The G.P. and H.E.R. is controlled by the C.P.R., as also is the Hull E.R. The G.P. and H.E.R. has 1.36 miles of double track, and 2.25 miles of sidings. Its freight cars ran 39,565 miles, and carried 153,729 tons of freight. The H.E.R. has 10.60 miles of double track, and 1.12 miles of sidings, and it leases 1.82 miles of track. Its freight cars ran 26,864 miles and carried 5,719 tons. (10) The G.V.R. owns also the Brantford

(10) The G.V.R. owns also the Brantford E. Ry. and the Woodstock, Thames Valley and Ingersoll, and its mileage includes these three lines. There are 1.95 miles of double track on these lines. It carried 264 tons of freight.
